States Served: Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Washington and Wyoming

Priority Activities in 2006 – 2007:

- Idaho: Assist the SEA in developing an implementation plan to provide training for K-2 teachers in using the Idaho K2 Mathematics Inventory (K2MI); and in the development of a plan for the SEA to assist districts with the implementation of the revised Idaho achievement standards.
- Montana: Provide technical assistance to create and implement the Montana systems of school support teams; provide content expertise for a review of state assessment items
- Oregon: Provide technical assistance to the SEA and Educational Service Districts (ESDs) on using data to inform decisions and techniques for monitoring and evaluating implementation efforts that are part of the state's continuous improvement process and on using data to drive decisions and techniques for monitoring and evaluating improvement efforts to help schools and districts make adequate yearly progress.
- Washington: Provide technical assistance, in collaboration with the SEA, to ESDs for the dissemination and use of a process designed to support district and school leaders responsible for implementing the SEA's guidelines for schools in Improvement Steps 4-5.
- Wyoming: Work with SEA staff to develop the content and delivery of workshops on interpreting state assessment results, AYP, and resources to support improved student learning; provide assistance to the SEA to enhance and update materials and resources on Title I schoolwide planning for use by LEA Title I directors.

- Key Activities: Three regional meetings are tentatively planned for 2007 on the following topics:
- Response to Intervention (follow-up to June 2006 regional meeting)
  - Building Successful SEA Models of Integrated Systems of Support
  - State Technology Coordinators -- Improving Data for Schools
